ORDER FOR SUPERVISED VISITATION-CASA VISITATION CENTER

4. The cost to each parent for use of the Visitation Center, will be assessed according to income and set on an individual sliding scale set by the Visitation Center based on

The Visitation Center will provide its fee scale on its website and upon request of a party. The fee scale may be amended periodically as needed by the Visitation Center.

Payments must be made prior to the visit and failure to pay may result in judgment against the responsible party.

5. The parties are ordered to follow the Rules and directives of the staff of the Visitation Center and the law enforcement agency at The Visitation Center.

6. The parties shall notify The Visitation Center if they cannot keep a scheduled appointment. Failure to do so will result in being required to pay for the appointment. Continued cancellations by either party may result in suspension of visits until further order of the Court. Two missed appointments without prior notification (failure to appear) by either party will be grounds for immediate termination of the services of The Visitation Center until further order of the Court.

7. The parties shall contact The Visitation Center at (727) 897-9204 within ten (10) days for an intake appointment. Each party shall pay an intake fee of twenty (\$20.00) dollars to the Visitation Center.

8. The Visitation Center and law enforcement personnel at The Visitation Center shall implement this Order by all lawful means to accomplish its purpose in providing safe and regular contact between the child/ren and parent. Observation Reports shall be submitted to the Court when requested by the Court or upon subpoena by a party. The Visitation Center may submit status reports to the Court as needed or upon request of the Court.

9. This Order will be reviewed at a Case Management Conference before the undersigned Judge on _____, 20___, at _____ . m. which both parties are hereby ordered to attend.
