- Minimum of ten hours within the last twelve months of CLE approved by the Florida Bar and devoted specifically to criminal law

Non-Capital Felony, Misdemeanor and Jimmy Ryce Appeals:

- Minimum of ten hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted specifically to appellate law
- Minimum of ten hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted specifically to criminal law

Jimmy Ryce Trials:

- Minimum of ten hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted specifically to criminal law

Juvenile Delinquency Trials:

- Minimum of ten hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted specifically to criminal law
- Minimum of three hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted specifically to delinquency law (may be included in the ten hours of CLE criminal law noted above)

Standard, Emergency, and After-Hours Emergency Guardianship, & Guardianship Appeals:

- Minimum of three hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted to guardianship law

Dependency, Attorney for Child, and Dependency Appeals:

- Minimum of three hours of CLE within the last twelve months approved by the Florida Bar and devoted to dependency law

Failure to comply with these professional requirements may result in the attorney being removed from all court-appointed lists for up to three years.

I certify that the answers given herein are true and complete. I understand that false or misleading information given in my application or omission of information requested will be grounds for refusal of appointment. I understand also if re-appointed, I will adhere to the contract issued by the Justice Administrative Commission and applicable Administrative Orders with the Sixth Judicial Circuit.
