
ORDERED:

1. The following commercial delivery services requiring a signed receipt may be used for formal notice pursuant to Florida Probate Rule 5.040 in cases pending in the Sixth Judicial Circuit:

- a. Airborne Express
- b. DHL Worldwide Express
- c. Federal Express
- d. United Parcel Service

2. Other commercial delivery services may be added to this approved list upon application to the Chief Judge.
