WHEREAS, Chapter 88-382, Laws of Florida, provides that Civil penalties may be satisfied through public works or community service where demonstrable financial hardship is shown, and


IN ORDER to provide for a uniform system for the implementation of this process, it is

ORDERED:

- 1) In any case in which civil penalties under Chapter 318 are to be paid, and where and when the person who owes a civil penalty so requests, the Clerk of the Court shall provide a Petition to Satisfy Civil Penalty through Public Works or Community Service Due to Financial Hardship as attached.
- 2) The person shall complete and return the affidavit to the Deputy Clerk.
- 3) On a weekly basis the Clerk shall present the Court file and the affidavit to the Court for disposition. No hearing shall be scheduled unless requested by the Court.
- 4) The Order on Petition to Satisfy Civil Penalties through Public Works or Community Service to be utilized in disposing of all such motions is attached.
- 5) The availability to satisfy civil penalties by public works or community service shall not be utilized in lieu of other fees or charges assessed by statute or rule. Nothing in this order shall prevent the Court from waiving the Clerk's fees.

ORDER ON PETITION TO SATISFY  
CIVIL PENALTIES THROUGH PUBLIC WORKS OR COMMUNITY SERVICE

THIS CAUSE having come upon the Petition to Satisfy Civil Penalties through Public Works or Community Service, and the Court having considered the Petition of the above referenced individual, it is

ORDERED:

/\_\_\_/ That the request is hereby DENIED.

/\_\_\_/ That the request is hereby APPROVED. Public works or community service shall be performed for such a period of time equal to the civil penalty at the hourly rate as petitioned and shall be completed within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order. Upon completion of said services, the above referenced individual shall bring an affidavit, in a form substantially similar to that form affidavit provided by the Clerk of Court, to the Clerk of the Court and request that civil penalties be formally satisfied. Upon the Petitioner's failure to provide this affidavit within ninety (90) days, the Clerk shall take such action as is required to suspend Petitioner's driver's license pursuant to Florida law. This authorization shall not be interpreted to waive any fees due and payable to the Department of Highway and Motor Vehicle Safety or the Clerk of the Court pursuant to applicable statutory or rule provisions.
