

Four Pasco Judges to Be Honored At Community Awards Luncheon

NEW PORT RICHEY – Four circuit judges who preside over Family Law Section cases in Dade City and New Port Richey will be honored Aug.20 during the first Family Partnerships Community Awards Luncheon, sponsored by the Pasco County Supervised Family Visitation Center.

Judges Shawn Crane, Daniel D. Diskey, Lynn Tepper and William R. Webb are scheduled to be among the guests at the event being held on the campus of the Calvary Chapel Worship Center, 6825 Trouble Creek Road, New Port Richey. A family re-united after working with the Visitation Center will be the featured speakers.

Dr. Tina White, director of the center, said the judges are being cited for “promoting healthy family values and striving to keep families safe.” The center contracts with the court to oversee court-ordered visits between parents and children when the court has ordered that the visits be supervised.

Dr. White said all four judges have been diligent in “keeping families safe and working for a good transition back together” when getting back together is appropriate.
