ORDER

Pursuant to discussions at the Brown Bag Lunch of May 8, 2015, it is ORDERED:

- A. Mediation on the temporary issue is mandatory prior to a temporary proffer hearing being scheduled.
- B. Proffers have previously been agreed upon by the Bar and Court and will be set for thirty (30) minutes. Proffer hearings must be noticed at "Proffer Hearing."
 - C. Any subsequent temporary relief hearings must be by evidentiary hearing.
- D. Three days prior to the proffer hearing, a Temporary Relief Hearing Memorandum must be filed by both parties and provided to opposing counsel or opposing party.
- E. If the requesting party fails to file the Temporary Relief Hearing Memorandum timely, the proffer hearing shall be cancelled. If the opposing party fails to file the documents required by the Temporary Relief Hearing Memorandum, the proffer hearing shall proceed if desired by the requested party.
