

SIXTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
MEDIATOR INFORMATION SHEET
****SMALL CLAIMS ONLY****

- All Small Claims mediators who wish to provide services for the Sixth Judicial Circuit must be certified by the Florida Supreme Court in County Mediation.
- Applicants will be scheduled to observe mediations once a completed application is received.
- Each mediator selected to serve must enter a contract with the Court.
- **Compensation:** Compensation for services is paid by the State of Florida at the rates set by the Court. The rates for payment in court-provided mediation are as follows:
 - **Pretrial Mediations** – \$20.00 per hour, except in Dade City (East Pasco), where the rate is \$22.00 per hour.
- **Expected Performance Details:** Each mediator serves pursuant to his/her availability and the Court's needs. Mediators providing small claims pretrial mediation should expect to serve for the entire calendar, approximately 6 to 8 hours for the day.
 - **Pasco County:**
 - East – Dade City:** Pretrial mediations are held *in person* every other Wednesday with court starting at 9:30 A.M.
 - West – New Port Richey:** Pretrial mediations are held *in person* Thursday with court starting at 9:00 A.M.
 - **Pinellas County:** Pretrial mediations are held *remotely*, via Zoom, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, varying from week to week starting at 8:30 A.M. The Zoom host as well as mediators sign on beforehand by 8:25 A.M.
 - **Tasks:** Besides mediating cases, mediators may be tasked by a Hearing Officer or Judge with administrative duties including identifying parties, assisting parties with completing and signing documents, and relaying parties' questions to the Court.
- **Other Resources:** Rule 10, Rules for Certified and Court-appointed Mediators; Rule 1.720, Rules of Civil Procedure; and Chapter 44, Florida Statutes.

The Court is currently soliciting for Small Claims mediators only.
