RE: MISDEMEANOR PROBATION SERVICES

On September 1, 2013, the Salvation Army Correctional Services will no longer be providing supervisory services for misdemeanor defendants placed on probation. Instead, starting on this date, the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office will be the new provider of these services. This will require a change in the reporting practices of defendants whose probation orders require them to report to the Salvation Army Correctional Services after September 1, 2013.

In accordance with Article V, §2, Florida Constitution, Rules of Judicial Administration 2.215 and 2.525, and section 43.26, Florida Statutes,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Beginning 12:01 a.m. September 1, 2013, any defendant who has not completed their period of probation and who has been ordered to report to the Salvation Army Correctional Services shall stop reporting to the Salvation Army Correctional Services and begin reporting to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office Misdemeanor Probation. This office is located at 14250 49th Street North, Room 1400, Clearwater, Florida 33762 and will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The phone number for the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office Misdemeanor Probation is (727) 464-8100.
- 2. All other conditions of probation remain in full force and effect to the extent that they are offered by the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office.
