**RE: PINELLAS COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD – APPOINTMENT OF
SUBSTITUTE MEMBER FOR SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS**

The Chief Judge has been notified that the Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections is disqualified from serving on the County Canvassing Board for Pinellas County for the August 2024 election cycle pursuant to section 102.141(1), Fla. Stat., and that Herb Polson, a former member of the St. Petersburg City Council and previous member of the County Canvassing Board for Pinellas County, is willing and able to serve as a substitute member.

In accordance with Article V, section 2, Florida Constitution, Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215, and sections 43.26 and 102.141(1), Fla. Stat., it is

ORDERED:

Herb Polson, a qualified elector, is hereby appointed as the substitute member for the Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections, to serve on the Pinellas County Canvassing Board for the August 2024 election cycle.
