**ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

**THIS CAUSE** came before the Court on the "Petition for Appeal of Pinellas County Code Enforcement Special Magistrate" filed by pro se Petitioner, Kenneth Brown on June 4, 2008. An Order to file proper petition and Notice of intent to dismiss was filed on July 15, 2008. On July 24, 2008, Petitioner filed a proper Petition seeking a Writ of Certiorari to quash the order of the Pinellas County Enforcement Board (The Board) and attached the order which this court has now reviewed.

After review, this Court denies the Petition for Writ of Certiorari as the initial filing was untimely. The Board on April 28, 2008 entered an Order on Repeat Violation Imposing Fine, Lien and Costs. The Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure require that certiorari appeals to the circuit court from a final administrative decision are required to be filed within thirty days of the decision to be reviewed. *Fla. R. App. P. Rule 9.100*. The initial filing by Petitioner was on June 4, 2008. Accordingly, the Court is without jurisdiction to review the merits of the Petition for Writ of Certiorari. *Harris v. Conderman*, 113 So.2d 235, 238 (Fla. 3d DCA 1959)(citations omitted); *Thermoplastic & Signs, Inc. v. Metropolitan Dade County*, 746 So.2d 1140, 1141 (Fla. 3d DCA 1999).

Accordingly, it is:

**ORDERED** that the above-styled Petition for Writ of Certiorari is DENIED.
