**ORDER AND OPINION**

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the defendant, Jesse Toca's, appeal from a decision of the Pinellas County Court summarily dismissing his motion for post-conviction relief. After reviewing the record and the defendant's brief, this Court affirms the trial court's decision.

The trial court properly dismissed the defendant's motion for post-conviction relief because it was facially insufficient --- he failed to make the motion under oath as required by Fla.R.Crim.P. 3.850. The defendant's argument that his religious beliefs prevent him from complying with the oath requirement was essentially addressed by the

Second District Court of Appeal in Toca v. State, 866 So.2d 1221 (Fla. 2d DCA 2003).

The court was not persuaded by the defendant's argument.

Similarly, the trial court, while recognizing that the defendant's argument was somewhat different to that raised in Toca, was not persuaded. This Court agrees. The defendant's failure to file the motion for post-conviction relief under oath requires its summary dismissal. The defendant's argument that his religious beliefs exempt him from the oath requirement is not persuasive as a matter of law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the order dismissing the defendant's motion for post-conviction relief is affirmed.


